Description: Every week, each class will have the opportunity to attend special on-campus workshop classes, all of which will be led by our very own instructor, Cline. In each on-campus class, you will have the opportunity to learn about an academic topic and enjoy communicating with your classmates face-to-face. Each lesson will give you the opportunity to exercise your Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing skills in a communicative way. *Please note: These On-Campus Workshop Classes are voluntary (not compulsory); they will not affect any classroom grades. If the pandemic worsens and requires LUJ campus to close, these classes will continue online and all students will be expected to participate.*

Schedule: Check the schedule above to see what time and day is reserved for your class every week (†excluding non-normal class days, such as exam days, TOEFL Day, etc.).

IN-1 students should note that their on-campus class is scheduled in the afternoon, as it was not possible to schedule it in the morning.

Signing up: All students will receive a link to a SignUp Genius sign-up sheet. **[DEADLINE]: Sign up by 12pm the day before your class** to say whether you will attend the class on-campus. If you sign up to attend the class, it is important to attend – and, if you cannot, please contact Cline directly via email to inform him. The sign-up sheet will be managed by the EAP Coordinator, but Cline will also be able to see which students have signed up. If you decide at the last minute that you would like to attend but you didn't sign up, please feel free to join the class. You can email Cline directly to let him know that you are planning to attend.

Covid19 Safety Precautions: LUJ wants to help students feel as comfortable as possible and to keep your health and safety as your top priority. Your classroom will be large, well-ventilated, with plenty of hand sanitizer available and distance between desks. All students will be expected to follow the necessary safety guidelines and precautions as advised.

***Students who cannot join the on-campus classes** will use these lesson times in diverse ways, according to their teachers' instructions. For example, it may be used as study period for tasks such as catching up on homework, doing make-up assessments, meeting 1:1 with your teacher, doing independent TOEFL practice, and so on. These are **not** free periods – **these lesson periods must still be spent working on classwork**, and attendance **will** still be taken on these days. Your regular teachers will inform you of how to record your attendance on these days (whether by signing in on Zoom, signing in on a Google Doc, or in another way), and will give you specific instructions for these lessons.

****Students who cannot join the on-campus classes** will have the opportunity to join an abbreviated make-up online version of the workshop classes every Monday, which will review some of the content (the highlights) that was taught to students in the on-campus sessions during the previous week. Students who choose to join these Monday online sessions must still attend their regular EAP classes on Mondays and will be expected to keep up with their regular classwork. **Students who joined the previous week's on-campus session are not eligible to join these online reviews.* **[DEADLINE]: Sign up for these extra Monday Zoom sessions by 12pm the day before the class (on Sundays),** using the SignUp Genius sheet provided. If you decide at the last minute that you would like to attend but you didn't sign up, please feel free to join this class.
