# **FIRE EVACUATION PROCEDURES**

## If there is a **FIRE** on campus

Follow these steps:

- 1. If you are the first to discover the fire, **pull the fire alarm** immediately.
- 2. If you hear the fire alarm, immediately **prepare to evacuate** via the outside stairwell.
- 3. Calmly follow the stairwell down to the ground floor. **DO NOT USE THE ELEVATOR.**
- 4. Head to the appointed Evacuation Area (**Tenjin Elementary School**).
- 5. Do not return to campus until the all-clear announcement has been made.

## **EARTHQUAKE EVACUATION PROCEDURES**

## In the event of an EARTHQUAKE

Follow these steps:

- 1. The initial strong shakes of an earthquake may last only a few seconds to minutes. Protect yourself from falling objects by **ducking under a desk**. Stay away from windows. Open the door to secure an exit.
- 2. Once the initial shaking stops, follow teacher and staff instructions to calmly begin exiting via the outside stairwell. **DO NOT USE THE ELEVATOR.**
- 3. Head to the appointed Evacuation Area (**Tenjin Elementary School**). Protect yourself from falling objects and watch out for other hazards.
- 4. Once you reach the evacuation area, check in with your teacher for **attendance**.
- 5. **Await further instructions** from staff, emergency response teams, and/or broadcasted public announcements. Remain calm and do not leave the evacuation area.
- 6. Do not return to campus until the **all-clear announcement** has been made.

#### **FIRST-AID PROCEDURES**

### If you find someone who is, or you are, in need of FIRST-AID

**First-aid should be performed only if medical or trained personnel are not immediately available**. Perform first-aid only to the extent you are capable and comfortable with.

First, calm yourself by breathing deeply. Then, proceed as follows:

- 1. **Check the scene.** Is it safe to enter? If the scene is unsafe, DO NOT attempt to enter. If the scene is safe, check the victim for life-threatening conditions. Check for: breathing, other signs of life (movement, etc.), and for visible signs of injury. DO NOT attempt to move the victim.
- 2. Immediately **call the Administrative Office (03-3225-0425)** and calmly provide your own and the victim's name, your location, and a clear description of the current condition.

For minor / basic first-aid needs, first-aid kits are located near the elevators on each floor of LUJ's campus buildings.
