

## **TOEFL Exemption for Admissions**

### **Undergraduate Applicants**

### **International Students**

International students must demonstrate proficiency in English as one of the admissions requirements for the Academic Program. A minimum of 500 on the paper-based TOEFL, 173 on the computer-based TOEFL [CBT] or 61 on the internet-based TOEFL [iBT] is required. The Test of English as a Foreign Language [TOEFL] is required for all applicants whose native language is not English.

Exempt from submitting TOEFL scores are applicants that have:

- Earned a high school diploma from a high school in the English education system in any English speaking countries/regions.
- Completed a minimum of one term of full time post-secondary academic studies in the United States, Canada, UK, Australia, or New Zealand where English proficiency is required for admission.
- Acceptable GCE Ordinary Level or Advanced Level results, GCSE results or acceptable test results of Senior Secondary Certificate Examinations [SSCE] by the West African Examinations Council.
- Acceptable IELTS scores [minimum 6 for the Academic Program]

The TOEFL score is not required but recommended for admission to the English for Academic Purposes (EAP) program. Students currently in the college's EAP program must meet the exit criteria to begin their studies in the Academic Program at LCJ.
