

Tuition and Fees

EAP : Tuition, facility fee, SGA fee and the school fee for the 1st year will have been taken care of at the time of enrollment. Beginning in the 2nd year, these fees are to be paid semesterly.

Academic : Tuition depends on the number of classes and credits taken by the student during the semester and is decided following a consultation with their advisor. Normally, students take 12-14 credits (4 classes) per semester. Tuition is 46,200 yen per credit (including tax).

If payments have not been confirmed after 5 days of the beginning of the semester, all registered classes will be cancelled. In addition, the student will be automatically placed under a retroactive fallen out of enrollment status wherein their final enrollment date will be adjusted to the end of the last semester they fully paid. Please prepare well in advance if you apply for a student loan, etc. In the event that the payment is to fail to meet the deadline, please contact the financial affairs office (financialaffairs@japan.lakeland.edu) before the due date.

Types of Fees and Annual Schedule for Payment

There are two types of fees: Tuition (which includes tuition, facility fee, SGA fee and general activity fee), and Non Tuition-Based Fees (which includes textbooks, ITP TOEFL, cap & gown fee, tassel fee and diploma fee).

Note to ITP TOEFL

EAP : EAP students must take ITP TOEFL (on-campus) each semester.

*Bridge students and students who already have a 500 score are exempted from taking ITP TOEFL test.

Academic : Non-native-English speaking students without an ACT or SAT score must take TOEFL test (ITP or IBT) during the expected graduation semester; however, students who wish to take TOEFL in other semesters can also sign up for the test.

ITP TOEFL Fee

Please note that LUJ will charge a TOEFL fee even if the student does not take the test due to illness, LOA, withdrawal from school during the semester, etc. as materials are ordered at the beginning of the semester.
