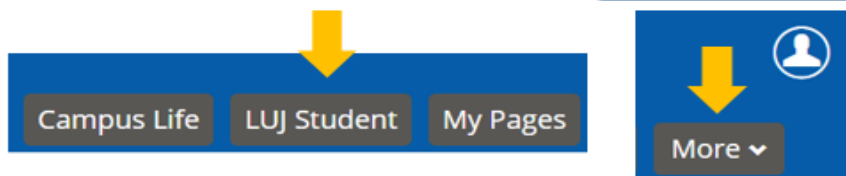

- Your Advisor is your ally who will help you;
 - a) adjust to university life and university procedures,
 - b) find out your academic progress, and
 - c) give you advice whenever you are struggling with your studies.
- You will meet your advisor at least two times per term.
 - a) At the beginning term (by the end of week 1)
 - b) After midterms (during Advising Period)

Step #1: Go to “LUJ Student”

- Log in to your my.lakeland account.
 - User Name = your LUW ID number (6 digits)
 - Password = password you set up when you created your account.
- On the main page, look for the **LUJ Student** button on the page navigation bar.

*If the choice does not appear in the bar, click on the “more” tab to reveal it.



Step #2: Scroll down to “Academic Information”

Your advisor’s name will appear in this section.
