ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To apply to Lakeland University Japan, applicants must meet <u>ONE</u> of the following requirements:

- 1. Have graduated or will graduate from a secondary school (High School or a total of 12 years of education)
- 2. Have a Secondary School Graduate Equivalent Certificate (GED)
- 3. Have completed the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program*


Students from countries whose education, including secondary school, is less than 12 years need to have their education qualifications evaluated individually. Lakeland University Japan (LUJ) currently offers two types of programs at the Japan Campus: The Undergraduate Program, and the English for Academic Purposes (EAP)

Program. These programs are open to both Japanese and International students.

UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM

The Undergraduate Program is for degree-seeking students. The courses in this program follow the curriculum of a typical American Liberal Arts education. Students who wish to enter this program must fulfill one of the following conditions:

- Their native language is English or they have graduated from an international high school with an English based curriculum.
 OR
- 2. They have an English proficiency of at least TOEFL ITP 500, iBT* 61, IELTS 6, Oxford ELLT 6, and Duolingo** scores of 100 or higher. TOEFL/IELTS/Duolingo will be exempt if students have transferred credits of 30 semester hours from a U.S. institution and a GPA of 2.0 or higher from another college or university in an English speaking country, or an Acceptable GCE Ordinary or Advanced Level results or acceptable WAEC test results.
 - *TOEFL school code: 8962 **Duolingo: search for Lakeland University Japan as institution.

POSTGRADUATE PROGRAM

To apply to a master level program, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Have completed a baccalaureate degree
- 2. Their native language is English

OR



They have an English proficiency of at least TOEFL ITP 550, iBT* 80, IELTS 7, and Duolingo** scores of 130 or higher. → TOEFL/IELTS/Duolingo will be exempt if students have completed their bachelor degree from a U.S. institution, or college or university in an English speaking country, with a GPA of 2.75 or higher.

Typically a cumulative undergraduate GPA of at least 2.75 or a minimum score of 450 on the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) is required for admission. <u>However</u>, admissions decisions are made with consideration of the candidate's application in its entirety.

FOUNDATION COURSES

Course work of a "C" or better in the areas of **economics**, **statistics**, **finance**, **and accounting** preferred. If no evidence of completed course work is provided, students have the option to complete two courses at the graduate level focusing on economics/statistics and finance/accounting to meet these requirements.

ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES [EAP] PROGRAM


The English for Academic Purposes (EAP) is an intensive program designed to bring focus and attention to the various skills, both language and study, needed to succeed at an American university. After completing the EAP Program, 12 college credits will be transferable towards their Lakeland degree.

There are 5 levels in total. Which level you start at will be determined by your current level of English.

► OFFICIAL SCHOOL TRANSCRIPTS - IN ENGLISH

An official English transcript from the accredited high school and/or university/college where you are currently studying (or have already graduated from). This includes military transcripts. If you are/ were enrolled in a Japanese language school, please submit the grades and attendance report.

If you have 12 credits or more in higher education, you do not need to provide high school transcripts.

For official transcripts and scores:

- American please send them in either two methods; emailed by your school, or through a digital credential service, such as
 <u>Parchment</u> (enter <u>admissions@japan.lakeland.edu</u> as the receiver), <u>National Student ClearingHouse</u>, etc. If you have *AP or SAT* scores. please submit them through College Board SAT, AP
- Non-American please send them through a digital credential service please use ECE link 10% disc or WES
- In Japan please send them in either two methods; mailed to our address in Japan in a sealed envelope or emailed by your school (UNLESS they are College/University transcripts please use ECE link 10% disc.)

Note: Any official transcripts cannot be sent by the applicant themselves.

For ECE reports, please select "general" report for high school or "course by course" report for GCSE, A-Levels, & college/ University

The evaluation can take several weeks to complete, so please plan accordingly - see page 8

► CERTIFICATE OF HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION OR A COPY OF YOUR DIPLOMA

You must submit a certificate of graduation or a copy of your high school diploma in English. If you apply prior to your high school graduation, please submit a letter with your anticipated graduation date (in English).

Note: An Application for Admission may be submitted at any time after the successful completion of the junior year of secondary school.

► REQUIRED ENGLISH PROFICIENCY TEST SCORES FOR NON-NATIVE ENGLISH SPEAKERS

For applicants who graduated from a non-English curriculum based high school:

- EAP applicants must be able to write basic sentences and hold a basic conversation in English. Scores provided will be used to determine EAP starting levels.
- Undergraduate an official TOEFL score of iTP 500, iBT 61, IELTS 6, Oxford ELLT 6, or Duolingo 100 taken within 1 year is required
 for direct entry.
- Postgraduate an official TOEFL score of iTP 550, iBT 80, IELTS 7, or Duolingo 130 taken within 1 year is required for direct entry, or if you have obtained your bachelor degree from a U.S. institution or other English-based institution with a GPA of 2.75 or higher.

PERSONAL STATEMENT OF PURPOSE -TYPED, WRITTEN IN ENGLISH, 300-400 WORDS

In this statement you must introduce yourself and your previous education background, as well as your future educational and career goals and interests. Explain why you would like to enter LUJ, and add any other information you think is relevant.

► LETTER OF REFERENCE

This letter should be written by a former or current teacher, guidance counselor, professor, or employer. It must include their reasons why you would be a good candidate for our program. We will not accept letters written by family members or friends. This letter must be in English, with the exception of Japanese language school instructors or counselors, and can be emailed directly to the admissions office (admissions@iapan.lakeland.edu) in either pdf. word. or direct email format.

For postgraduate applications, an official template must be used. This will be provided by the admissions team.

► PASSPORT / JAPANESE RESIDENCE CARD

Send a copy of the pages of your passport that include your legal name, birth date, passport number, and pictures, along with past entry stamp pages to and from Japan. If you are already in Japan on a current visa, send a copy of the front and back of your residence card.

► INTERVIEW REQUIREMENTS

Students who are applying to the undergraduate or postgraduate program are required to participate in an official interview. Acceptance will be determined by the application document review and interview results.

TRANSFER ADMISSIONS



Lakeland has a generous transfer credit from previous institutions policy, accepting up to:

45 credits for the A.A. degree 90 credits for the B.A degree and 9 credits for the postgraduate degrees.

- If you are transferring to LUJ from another college, only courses similar to those offered at LUJ will be transferable. Moreover, you must have earned a grade of "C" or better for your credits to transfer.
- All work completed at other colleges will be converted to semester hours when evaluating transferable credits, as to make it match with LUJ's three-credit-based curriculum.*
- You will start with a new GPA when you enter LUJ; grades earned at other colleges will not be included in your new GPA.
- If you transfer to LUJ with 30 or more credits earned at another college or university, you will be exempt from LUJ's Interdisciplinary Studies Requirement (also called "Core 1").
- Transfer courses must have been taken within 10 years prior to application to the graduate program.

For students who have transcripts from colleges or universities that are non-U.S., Educational Credential Evaluators, Inc. (ECE) reviews educational achievements by individuals from other countries and converts them to the U.S. system for purposes of studying or working in the U.S.



APPLYING FOR A STUDENT VISA

► NON-JAPANESE CITIZENS **OUTSIDE OF JAPAN**



CONFIDENTIAL FINANCIAL CERTIFICATION FORM

This document pertains to the person/organization who is financially supporting your education. You must use the form provided, and you must write it in English.

Optional (recommended):

Working Permission Application Form

BANK STATEMENT

A bank statement of the person providing financial support is required. They must have approximately ¥1,500,000 or more in the account - the currency may be that of your own country.


► DIGITAL OR PHYSICAL PHOTOGRAPHS

Two drivers-license-sized photos or a jpeg photo are required. They must be 4x3 cm, well lit (avoid shadows), plain white background, and must have been taken within the past 6 months. Glasses, hats or other headgear are not permitted.

► PASSPORT COPY

Send a copy of the pages of your passport that include your photo, legal name, birth date and passport number.

The expiration date needs to be <u>longer than 6 months</u> in order to apply for a student visa.



- **3.** LUJ will submit the student visa application documents to the Immigration Bureau <u>after the application deadline.</u>
- The Immigration Bureau takes approximately 6-8 weeks to approve the visa application and issue a <u>Certificate of</u> Eligibility (CoE).
- **5.** After receiving the approved CoE, LUJ will send it via your registered email address.
- You must take the CoE and your passport to the nearest Japanese embassy or consulate for final processing, which takes approximately 1-8 days depending on the embassy or consulate. Please confirm if additional documents are needed before visiting the embassy or consulate.
- Your passport will be stamped with the student visa and returned to you.
- **8.** You may now enter Japan.

APPLYING FOR A STUDENT VISA CONT'D

► NON-JAPANESE CITIZENS ALREADY IN JAPAN WITH A VALID STUDENT VISA

If you are living in Japan with a valid student visa from another institution, you will need to change your visa to an LUJ-sponsored student visa. LUJ will provide the required documents. You must submit these documents to the Immigration Services Agency of Japan.

► NOTIFICATION OF THE ACCEPTING ORGANIZATION FORM

This form requires information from your previous institution as well as from Lakeland University Japan. Our Student Affairs visa officer will provide you with this form after receiving the completed visa application form.

BANK STATEMENT OR PROOF OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT

A bank statement of the person providing financial support is required. They must have approximately ¥1,000,000 or more in the account - the currency may be that of your own country. Alternatively, you may provide Financial Aid or GI-Bill statements.

► ACADEMIC RECORD AND COMPLETION OF PREVIOUS INSTITUTION

This will need to be an official transcript. You may also submit a school completion certificate, graduation confirmation, or letter of withdrawal.



VISA SPONSORSHIP CHANGE APPLICATION PROCESS

- Complete the visa application form and submit.
- 2. Our visa officer will contact you with the Notification of the Accepting Organization form along with instructions for how to fill it
- **3.** Submit it to the Immigration Bureau <u>one</u> month prior to the start of the semester.

VISA RENEWAL APPLICATION PROCESS

- **1.** Submit the documents stated here to LUJ's Student Affairs Office.
- **2.** Pay the application fee (fees stated in form)
- **3.** Submit the student visa renewal documents to the Immigration Bureau
- 4. The Immigration Bureau takes approximately <u>2-4 weeks</u> to approve the visa renewal. You are still able to stay in the country until the visa renewal gets denied or approved.

- Plan on not receiving your MAH (Monthly Allowance for Housing) for 2-3 months. This does not mean it will take that long, but this is a precautionary measure.
- During the break in-between semesters, you will not receive MAH. You must be actively taking classes to receive MAH.
- Give the VA your bank information to receive your MAH directly into your account. Otherwise, a paper check will take longer to receive.
- Constantly update your address as you move.

Lakeland University Japan cannot determine benefits; only the VA can.
