

LUJ Culture and Sports Scholarship

Aimed at promoting the LUJ brand name by recruiting aspiring and promising students who can make contributions to society in the areas of sports and culture.

Application deadline: Friday 11:59pm, the day before graduation day of the semester for current LUJ student. For new applicants, application to this scholarship must be made upon application to LUJ programs and before admission decision is made.

Scholarship terms:

- Student must always wear the LUJ logo in a visible place, unless explicitly prohibited by competitions by law.
- Student participating in international events: receives 50% discount on tuition for the following semester.
- Student participating in national events: receive 30% discount on tuition for the following semester.
- Student participating in regional events (prefectural, ward or regional): receives 10% discount on tuition for the following semester.
- The scholarship applies to tuition fees only. All other fees must be paid in full.

Eligibility:

- Must have participated in a competition in the previous year.
- Must be privately funded or provide evidence of membership with a sports or cultural association. Students performing at a professional level, receiving remuneration or company sponsorship are not eligible.
- Must be an active member in a related club at LUJ.

For current students, the Student Affairs Office accepts applications throughout the semester until the deadline. If you are interested in applying for this scholarship before getting admitted to LUJ, please let the Admissions Team know your interest. An admissions officer will assist you with the process.

Students must submit the following documents to apply for this scholarship:

- Application form
- Certificate or document that could prove your participation in eligible events

- Any other documents that may prove your engagement in areas of sports and culture
